Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

CASTLE STREET (PEEL)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1993

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1 This Order may be cited as the Castle Street (Peel) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1993 and shall come into operation on the 15th March 1993.

Closure of Road to Traffic

2 No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in and along that length of Castle Street, Peel from its junction with Crown Street to its junction with Market Place.

Suspension of One-Way Traffic Scheme

3 During the period that the Order is in force the one-way traffic scheme imposed on Castle Street by Paragraph 2 (e) of the Peel Town Commissioners Road Traffic Regulations 1981 (b) is suspended.


Exemptions

4 Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to vehicles engaged in the sewer works to be undertaken.

Duration

5 This Order shall continue in force until the 17th March 1993 or until the sewer works being undertaken are completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic, other than authorised traffic, from proceeding in and along that length of Castle Street, Peel from its junction with Crown Street to its junction with Market Place whilst sewer works are being undertaken.

The one way traffic scheme imposed on Castle Street will be suspended during the period the Order is in force.

Alternative routes are via the Harbour and Station Hill.
