



SUMMARY JURISDICTION ACT 1989

SUMMARY TRIAL ORDER 1993

Approved by Tynwald 6th April 1993

Coming into operation 1 May 1993

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Home Affairs by section 16(10) of the Summary Jurisdiction Act 1989(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Summary Trial Order 1993 and, subject to section 16(11) of the Act, shall come into operation on 1 May 1993.

Interpretation

2. In this Order, "the Act" means the Summary Jurisdiction Act 1989.

Variation of Schedule 2 to Act

3. In Schedule 2 to the Act -

(a) for entry 1 substitute -

1. An offence under any of the following provisions of the Criminal Code 1872 (IV p.160) -

- "(a) section 16 (meetings for illegal training or drilling);
- (b) section 35 (wounding or inflicting grievous bodily harm);
- (c) section 49 (obstructing or assaulting a clergyman in the discharge of his duties);
- (d) section 51 (assault to commit offence or on peace officer);
- (e) section 55 (assaults arising from unlawful conspiracies etc.);
- (f) section 59 (aggravated assaults);

(a) 1989 c.15.

- (g) section 60 (assault occasioning actual bodily harm);
- (h) section 73 (concealing birth of child);
- (i) section 79 (criminal libel);
- (j) section 119 (obstructing engines or carriages on railways);
- (k) section 156 (unlawfully clipping sheep etc.);
- (l) section 318 (obstructing officer in execution of duty etc.);
- (m) section 319 (neglecting to execute writ etc.);
- (n) section 320 (prison breaking);
- (o) section 323 (bribery);
- (p) section 330 (conspiracy);
- (q) section 331 (falsely personating etc.);
- (r) section 332 (riot);
- (s) section 333 (forcible entry);
- (t) section 334 (forcible detainer).";

(b) after entry 1 insert -

"1A. An offence under section 38 of the Game Act 1882 (V p.173) (forging or altering licence under Act).

1B. An offence under any of the following sections of the Bankruptcy Code 1892 (VI p.312) -

- (a) section 86 (offences by debtors);
- (b) section 87 (undischarged bankrupt obtaining credit);
- (c) section 88 (fraudulently obtaining credit).

1C. An offence under any of the following sections of the Industrial and Building Societies Act 1892 (VI p.405) -

- (a) section 25 (commencing business before incorporation or neglecting to make returns);
- (b) section 27 (falsification of documents).

1D. An offence under section 6(2) of the Census Act 1929 (XII p.626) (unlawfully publishing information).";


(c) in entry 2, after sub-paragraph (c) insert -

"(ca) section 15 (unlawful possession of instruments etc. relating to stamps).";

- (d) in entry 3, add -
" (3) An offence under any of the following provisions of the Forgery Act 1952 (XVIII p.6) -
(a) section 4 (forgery of miscellaneous documents);
(b) section 10 (unlawful possession of bank note etc. paper and dies);
(c) section 11 (forgery of passport).";
- (e) after entry 3 insert -
"3A. An offence under the Perjury Act 1952 (XVIII p.86).
3B. An offence under section 26(1) of the Prison Act 1965 (XIX p.1450) (assisting prisoner to escape).";
- (f) in entry 4 after "under" insert "section 4(2) (sexual intercourse with a person over 13 but under 16 years of age), section 9(4) (gross indecency) or";
- (g) After entry 4 insert -
"4A. Any offence under the Prevention of Fraud (Investments) Act 1968 (XX p.387).";
- (h) for entry 6 substitute -
"6. Any offence under the Coinage Offences Act 1980(c.8).".
