Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (VARIOUS ROADS)
(RESERVED PARKING SPACES) (No 2) ORDER 1993

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1 This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Various Roads) (Reserved Parking Spaces) (No 2) Order 1993 and shall come into operation on the 23rd March 1993.

Interpretation

2 In this Order:-

"the Department" means the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties;

"reserved parking space" means the area of the highway designated as a parking space by article 3 of this Order;

"reserved permit" means a permit issued under the provision of article 4 of this Order.

Designation of Reserved Parking Spaces

3 The areas of the highways specified in the Schedule are designated as reserved parking spaces.

Vehicles for which Reserved Parking Spaces Designated

4 The Reserved Parking Spaces may be used, subject to the provisions of this Order, for the leaving of such vehicles displaying in the manner specified in Article 5 a reserved permit issued by the Department in respect of that vehicle.

Display of Permits

5 At all times during which a vehicle is left in the reserved parking space there shall be exhibited on the vehicle the permit issued in respect of the vehicle so that the particulars on the permit are readily visible from the front or near side of the vehicle.

Manner of Standing in Reserved Parking Spaces

6 Every vehicle left in the reserved parking spaces specified in the Schedule shall stand wholly within the limits of the reserved parking space and parallel to the kerb.

Power to Suspend use of Reserved Parking Spaces

7 (1) The Department may suspend the use of the reserved parking spaces or any part thereof whenever it considers such suspension reasonably necessary:-

- (a) for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety
- (b) for the purpose of any building operation, demolition or excavation in or adjacent to the reserved parking place or the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the reserved parking space or the laying, erection, alteration, removal or repair in or adjacent to the reserved parking space of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus
- (c) on any occasion on which it is likely by reason of some special attraction that the street will be thronged or obstructed.

(2) A police constable in uniform may suspend for not longer than twenty-four hours the use of a reserved parking space or any part thereof whenever he considers such suspension reasonably necessary for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety.


(3) Any person suspending the use of the reserved parking spaces or any part thereof in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (1) or paragraph (2) of this Article shall thereupon place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to that reserved parking space or the part thereof the use of which is suspended a traffic sign indicating that waiting by vehicles is prohibited.

(4) No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to be left in the reserved parking space or part of a reserved parking space during such period as there is in or adjacent to the reserved parking space or part of a reserved parking space a traffic sign placed in pursuance of paragraph (3) of this Article.

Movement of Vehicles in Reserved Parking Spaces in Emergency

8 A police constable in uniform may move or cause to be moved, in case of emergency, to any place he thinks fit any vehicle left in the reserved parking spaces.
