PUBLIC FOOTPATH NO 614 (LAXEY)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC) ORDER 1993

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Public Footpath No 614 (Laxey) (Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Traffic) Order 1993 and shall come into operation on the 3rd March 1993.

Closure of Footpath

2. Pedestrian traffic is prohibited from using the entire length of the foot-bridge on Public Right of Way No 614 over the Laxey River adjacent to the Fire Station.

Duration

3. This Order shall continue in force until the 3rd June 1993 or until the remedial works are completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit pedestrians from using the entire length of the footbridge on Public Right of Way No 614 over the Laxey River adjacent to the Fire Station during the period remedial works are being undertaken.

An alternative route will be via Mines Road.
