LHERGHY CRIPPERTY, (UNION MILLS)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1993

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a) and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Lherghy Cripperty (Union Mills) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1993 and shall come into operation on the 8th March 1993.

Closure of Road to Traffic

2. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in and along that length of the Lherghy Cripperty Road, Union Mills from a point immediately South of it's junction with the property known as 'Auldoon' to a point 100 metres North of the entrance to Ballarghy Farm.

Exemptions

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to vehicles engaged in the installation of a water main.

Duration

4. This Order shall continue in force until the 17th April 1993 or until the works being undertaken are completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic, other than authorised traffic, from proceeding in and along a length of the Lherghy Cripperty Road, Union Mills, during the installation of a water mains.

Alternative routes for traffic are via the Braaid or the Douglas to Peel Road.
