NORTH SHORE ROAD (RAMSEY)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1993

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1 This Order may be cited as the North Shore Road, Ramsey (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1993 and shall come into operation on the 14th March 1993.

Closure of Road to Traffic

2 No vehicular traffic shall proceed in that length of North Shore Road, Ramsey at its junction with Teares Terrace.


Exemptions

3 Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to vehicles and persons engaged in the sewer works to be undertaken.

Duration

4 This Order shall continue in force until the 16th March 1993 or until the sewer works are completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic, other than authorised traffic, from proceeding in that length of North Shore Road, Ramsey at its junction with Teares Terrace by reason of sewer works being undertaken.

Alternative routes will be via Bowring Road, Andreas Road, Bride Road to the Volland and the Mooragh Promenade.
