Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

UPPER RENCELL HILL (LAXEY)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1993

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a) of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1 This Order may be cited as the Upper Rencell Hill (Laxey) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1993 and shall come into operation on the 15th March 1993.

Closure of Road to Traffic

2 No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in and along that length of Upper Rencell Hill, Laxey from its junction with the Douglas/Ramsey Road to a point adjacent to the property known as Silversea.

Exemptions

3 Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to vehicles engaged in the gas pipe laying works to be undertaken.

Duration

4 This Order shall continue in force until the 28th March 1993 or until the works being undertaken are completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic, other than authorised traffic, from proceeding in and along that length of Upper Rencell Hill, Laxey from its junction with the main Douglas to Ramsey Road to a point adjacent to the property known as Silversea on Upper Rencell Hill for the period that gas pipe laying work is being undertaken.

An alternative route is via the D64 Chibbypheric Road.
