FISHING VESSELS (SURVEY AND INSPECTION) (FEES)
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 1993

Approved by Tynwald 6th. April, 1993

Coming into operation 12th April, 1993

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by section 6 of the Fishing Vessels (Safety Provisions) (Isle of Man) Act 1974 (a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and with the consent of the Treasury and after consultation with those persons who appear to the Department to be affected thereby, the following Regulations are hereby made:-

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Fishing Vessels (Survey and Inspection) (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 1993 and shall, subject to the approval of Tynwald, come into operation on the 12th April 1993.

Amendment of GC 374/90

2. Schedule 1 to the Fishing Vessels (Survey and Inspection) (Fees) Regulations 1990 (b) shall be amended as follows -

- (1) In paragraph 2, after the words "Subject to" insert "paragraph 2A and";
- (2) Omit paragraph 2(c); and
- (3) After paragraph 2, insert -

"2A Subject to any additional charge payable under Part IV of this Schedule, the fees for the following services in connection with the Merchant Shipping (Radio) (Fishing Vessels) Rules 1974 (c) as applied to the Island ("the Radio Rules") shall be -

- (i) in the case of a survey carried out in the Island in respect of compliance with Schedule 3 to the Radio Rules - £60;
- (ii) in the case of a survey carried out in the Island in respect VHF radiotelephone equipment carried in accordance with an exemption from full compliance with Schedule 3 to the Radio Rules - £45; and
- (iii) in the case of any survey carried out elsewhere than in the Island an hourly rate of £44. "

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Fishing Vessels (Survey and Inspection) (Fees) Regulations 1990 and prescribe the following new fees for the radio surveys of fishing vessels -

£60 in the case of a survey of single side band radiotelephone equipment in accordance with the Radio Rules carried out in the Island; and

£45 in the case of a survey, carried out in the Island, of VHF radiotelephone equipment carried in accordance with an exemption from the Merchant Shipping (Radio) (Fishing Vessels) Rules 1974

an hourly rate of £44 in the case of any radio survey carried out elsewhere than in the Island.
