Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

COLBY GLEN ROAD
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1993

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1 This Order may be cited as the Colby Glen Road (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1993 and shall come into operation on the 29th March 1993.

Closure of Road to Traffic

2 No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in and along that length of the Colby Glen Road from its junction with Costain Close southwards for a distance of 50 metres.

Exemptions

3 Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to vehicles engaged in the sewer works to be undertaken.

Duration

4 This Order shall continue in force until the 8th April 1993 or until the works being undertaken are completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic, other than authorised traffic, from proceeding in and along that length of the Colby Glen Road from its junction with Costain Close southwards for a distance of 50 metres whilst the sewer works are being undertaken.

An alternative route is via Ballagawne Road.
