Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

UNSURFACED HIGHWAY (LAXEY VILLAGE)
(PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1993

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1 This Order may be cited as the Unsurfaced Highway (Laxey Village) (Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1993 and shall come into operation on the 31st March 1993


Vehicles Prohibition

2 Save as provided in Article 3 no person shall cause any motor car to proceed in the whole of the Unsurfaced Highway in the village of Laxey known as Packhorse Lane, from its junction with the A2 Douglas to Ramsey Road to its junction with Breeze Hill.

Exemptions

3 Nothing in Article 2 shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing such vehicle to proceed in the roads referred to in that Article if the vehicle is being used by special written authorisation from the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties.

The effect of this Order is to prohibit all motor cars, except where special written authorisation has been given by the Department, the use of the unsurfaced highway known as Packhorse Lane, in the village of Laxey.
