Road Races Act 1982

PORT ERIN KART RACES ORDER 1993

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Races Act 1982 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1 This Order may be cited as the Port Erin Kart Races Order 1993 and shall come into operation on the 10th April 1993.

Interpretation

2 In this Order:-

"the Clerk of the Course" means the official so designated by the promoters in the official programme of the Manx Port Erin Kart Races and includes (in the absence of the Clerk of the Course) any Deputy Clerk of the Course so designated;

"the Course" means the roads and portions of roads set out and described in the Schedule and includes parts of the Course;

"the Department" means the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties;

"marshal" means a marshal appointed by the Chief Constable under Section 3 of the Road Race Act 1982;

"promoters" means the Isle of Man Kart Racing Association;

"practice day" and "race day" means the day specified in Article 4;

"practice periods" and "race periods" means the periods of time specified in Article 4 (2) when the course (subject to Article 3) is closed to traffic in order to permit practicing and racing and purposes incidental thereto.

Closure of Course to Traffic and Suspension of Right of Way

3 During the practice periods and the race periods on the practice day and the race day, the course shall, subject to subparagraphs (a) to (f) be closed to, and the right of way thereover suspended for, all traffic other than:-

Duty of Police to Notify Completion of Practicing and Racing

6 On completion of practicing and racing earlier than the times specified in this Order, or in any event, it shall be the duty of the Clerk of the Course (or the senior police officer present in conjunction with the Clerk of the Course) to ensure that such completion is officially notified to the public with all reasonable expedition and for such purpose an official motor vehicle displaying in a prominent position a notice with the words "Roads Open" thereon shall proceed around the course. The passing of any part of the Course by such vehicle shall be official notification of the completion of the practices and races as regards such portion so passed which shall thereupon be open again for traffic.

Re-opening of the Course During Intervals between Practices and Races

7 Notwithstanding the provisions of Article 3, during any intervals as determined by the Clerk of the Course between the practice sessions occurring in the practice period and any intervals between races for different classes of motor karts occurring in the race periods traffic may cross or proceed along the Course but only when permitted by a constable or special constable.

Promoters to Secure Insurances and Indemnities

8 The promoters shall secure adequate insurances and indemnities against injury or damage to persons or property arising out of the conduct of the practices and races and the arrangements incidental thereto, and shall indemnify the Department against any claim or liability arising therefrom and shall take out adequate insurance to support or cover such indemnity.


Restriction on Breaking up the Course for Road Works

9 Paragraph 9 (1) of Schedule 4 (the Road Works Code) to the Highways Act 1986 shall apply to the Course from the 15th March 1993 to the 10th April 1993.

Notice of the Making of the Order

10 Public notice of this Order shall be given by advertisement in two or more Isle of Man newspapers.

IN THE TOWN OF PORT ERIN

1 That length of Shore Road from a point adjacent to the George Herdman Institute to its junction with Breakwater Road. The entire length of Breakwater Road to the western end of the Marine Biological Station. That length of unnamed road fronting the Marine Biological Station in an easterly direction to its junction with Breakwater Road.

2 Those portions of all roads leading into the foregoing roads from such point thereon as as may be fixed by or on behalf of the Department and indicated by barriers.
