Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

QUEEN STREET (PEEL)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1993

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1 This Order may be cited as the Queen Street (Peel) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1993 and shall come into operation on 29th March 1993.

Closure of Road to Traffic

2 No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that section of Queen Street, Peel abutting the properties numbered 7, 9, 11 and 13.


Exemptions

3 Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to vehicles engaged in the gas main laying work to be carried out.

Duration

4 This Order shall continue in force until 4th April or until the gas mains work being undertaken is completed whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding in that section of Queen Street, Peel abutting the properties numbered 7, 9, 11 and 13 whilst gas main laying work is being undertaken.

An alternative route will be via Beach Street or Market Street, the one way system on Beach Street being suspended during the period that this Order is in force.
