Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

GLENCRUTCHERY ROAD (DOUGLAS)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1993

Coming into Operation: 18th April 1993

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1 This Order may be cited as the Glencrutchery Road (Douglas) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1993 and shall come into operation at 9.00 a.m. on 18th April 1993.

Closure of Road to Traffic

2 No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that section of Glencrutchery Road, Douglas from its junction with the Cemetery to a point adjacent to the property known as Mountain View.

Exemptions

3 Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to vehicles engaged in the bridge erection work to be carried out.

Duration

4 This Order shall continue in force until 12 noon on 18th April 1993, or until the bridge erection work being undertaken is completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding in that section of Glencrutchery Road, Douglas from its junction with the Cemetery to a point adjacent to the property known as Mountain View whilst bridge erection work is being undertaken.

An alternative route will be via Dukes Road and Victoria Road.
