Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

VILLIERS LANE/STRAND LANE/GRANVILLE LANE (DOUGLAS)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) (NO 2) ORDER 1993

Coming into Operation: 14th April 1993

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1 This Order may be cited as the Villiers Lane/Strand Lane/Granville Lane (Douglas) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) (No 2) Order 1993 and shall come into operation on the 14th April 1993.

Closure of Road to Traffic

2 No vehicular traffic shall proceed in and along Villiers Lane, Strand Lane and Granville Lane in the Borough of Douglas.


Exemption

3 Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to vehicles engaged in the works to be carried out.

Duration

4 This Order shall continue in force until and including 3rd May 1993 or until the sewer refurbishment work being undertaken is completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This Note is not a Part of the Order)

The effect of this order is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding along Villiers Lane, Strand Lane and Granville Lane, Douglas during the period sewer refurbishment works are being undertaken.
