THE LOCH PROMENADE (DOUGLAS) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING)  
(AMENDMENT) ORDER 1993

Coming into operation: 23rd April 1993

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Loch Promenade (Douglas) (Restriction of Waiting) (Amendment) Order 1993 and shall come into operation on 23rd April 1993

Amendment of GC 391/92

2. At the end of article 10 of the Loch Promenade (Douglas) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1992 (b) add the following -

"with effect from the date of commencement of this Order until the 1st October 1993 the said waiting area shall not be diagonal to the carriageway".

Amendment of the Parking Places (Consolidation) Order 1991

3. Entry 43 in Schedule 1 to the Parking Places (Consolidation) Order 1981 shall be amended as follows -

(1) For column 2 substitute "as indicated by white lines"; and

(2) In column 5, omit the words "Diagonal parking with rear of vehicles to the kerb".
