
Citation

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This Note is not part of the Order)

This Order brings into operation provisions of the Contracts (Applicable Law) Act 1992 which relate to the making of Orders to take account of changes to the Conventions applied by the Act and supplementary provisions. It is intended to take account of the accession of Spain and Portugal to the principal Convention before bringing the substantive provisions of the Act into operation.
