HIGHWAYS ACT 1986

ST MARKS VILLAGE FAIR ORDER 1993

Coming into Operation: 24th July 1993

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by Section 38 of the Highways Act 1986 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1 This Order may be cited as St Mark's Village Fair Order 1993 and shall come into operation on the 24th July 1993.

Interpretation

2 In this Order:-

"the Department" means the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties;

"Fair" means the St Mark's Village Fair;

"Fair period" means from the hour of 1.30 p.m. until the Fair is officially notified as completed in accordance with Article 4, or until not later than the hour of 5.00 p.m. whichever is the earlier;

"the promoters" means the St Mark's Village Fair Committee;

"scheduled road" means the road set out and described in the Schedule.

PART I

Closure of Road and Temporary Suspension and Regulation of Traffic

3 On the 24th July 1993 during the Fair Period the scheduled road shall be closed to, and the right of vehicular traffic to proceed thereover suspended for all vehicular traffic other than such traffic as may be authorised by the Promoters or by the Chief Constable.

Duty of Police to Notify Completion of Fair

4 It shall be the duty of the senior police officer present to make such provision as seems to him most expedient for giving official notification to the public of the conclusion of the Fair and of the opening of the scheduled road to traffic.

PART II

Erection of Barriers

5 During the Fair period on the 24th July 1993, the Promoters may cause barriers to be erected and maintained along the length of the scheduled road and at, or near to the junction of the scheduled road with those roads leading into the scheduled road. Such barriers must be dismantled and removed immediately after the conclusion of the Fair period.

Erection of Stalls

6 During the Fair period the Promoters may permit persons to erect stalls on the scheduled road upon such terms and conditions as the Promoters may stipulate.


