**CRIMINAL JUSTICE ACT 1990 (APPOINTED DAY) (NO 2) ORDER 1993**

Laid before Tynwald: 15th June 1993

Coming into operation: 1st June 1993

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Home Affairs by section 35 (2) of the Criminal Justice Act 1990 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Criminal Justice Act 1990 (Appointed Day) (No 2) Order 1993.

Appointed Day

2. Sections 27 and 28 of the Criminal Justice Act 1990 shall come into operation on 1st June 1993.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order)

This Order brings into operation on 1st June 1993 the provisions of sections 27 and 28 of the Criminal Justice Act 1990 which provide for the giving of evidence in criminal proceedings through a live television link or by means of a video recording in certain circumstances. All the other provisions of the Act were brought into operation on 1st March 1990.
