Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

NORTH QUAY (DOUGLAS) (DISABLED PERSONS' VEHICLES
STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 1993

Coming into Operation: 15th June 1993

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1 (1) This Order may be cited as the North Quay (Douglas) (Disabled Persons' Vehicles Street Parking Places) Order 1993 and shall come into operation on the 15th June 1993

(2) In this Order:-

"driver" in relation to a vehicle waiting in a parking place means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place;

"parking place" means any part of a road authorised by this Order to be used as a parking place; and

"restricted period" means the period between 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive.

"Regulations" means the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1981 made by the Secretary of State for Transport, the Secretary of State for Scotland and the Secretary of State for Wales as they have effect in the Isle of Man by virtue of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1982 (b).

Authorisation and Use of Parking Place

2 The part of the road specified in column 1 of the Schedule may be used, subject to Article 3, as a parking place solely for disabled persons' vehicles in such positions on such days and during such hours as are specified in relation to that part of the road specified in the Schedule.

Other Provisions

3 (1) The driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in the parking place during the restricted period for longer than the maximum period permitted for waiting specified in the Schedule in relation to that parking place;

(2) The driver of a vehicle using a parking place shall display on the dashboard of the vehicle a badge authorising the use of the parking place.

(3) The driver of a motor vehicle using the parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the parking place, and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the parking place.


(4) No person shall use a vehicle, while is is in the parking place, in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skills or services.

(5) No person shall use any part of the parking place for the purpose of servicing or washing any vehicle or part thereof other than is reasonably necessary to enable that vehicle to depart from the parking place.

(6) The Chief Constable may for good and sufficient reason prohibit the use of the parking place during such times as may be reasonably necessary.

(7) The Department may suspend the use of the parking place on giving notice seven days prior to such suspension.

Explanatory Note
(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to designate two parking places on the North Quay, Douglas for disabled persons vehicles. The parking spaces so authorised in North Quay are limited to a maximum waiting period of 90 minutes in any 2 hours between 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. Monday to Saturday inclusive.
