Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

WATERLOO ROAD (RAMSEY)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) (No 2) ORDER 1993

Coming into Operation: 1st May 1993

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985(a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1 This Order may be cited as the Waterloo Road (Ramsey) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) (No 2) Order 1993 and shall come into operation on 1st May 1993.

Closure of Road to Traffic

2 No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that section of Waterloo Road, Ramsey from its junction with Queens Drive to its junction with Waterloo Lane.

Exemptions

3 Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to vehicles engaged in the sewerage work to be carried out.

Duration

4 This Order shall continue in force until 23rd May 1993, or until the sewerage work being undertaken is completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding in that section of Waterloo Road, Ramsey from its junction with Queens Drive to its junction with Waterloo Lane whilst sewerage work is being undertaken.

An alternative route will be via Stanley Mount East
