

THE CHURCH ACT 1969

THE SEQUESTRATION FEES ORDER 1997

*Coming into operation*      *1st February 1997*

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Bishop by section 6(1) of the Church Act 1969(a), the following Order is hereby made:—

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Sequestration Fees Order 1997 and shall come into operation on the 1st February 1997.

**Sequestration fees**

2. (1) Subject to paragraph (2), the following fees are prescribed as the remuneration to be paid to clerks in Holy Orders who perform occasional ecclesiastical duties in vacant benefices —

| <i>Service</i>   | <i>Fee</i> |
|--|------------|
| Holy Communion, Morning Prayer or Evening Prayer                   | £12.00     |
| Holy Communion, Morning Prayer or Evening Prayer<br>with sermon    | £15.00     |
| Children's service or other special service with sermon            | £15.00     |
| Morning Prayer or Evening Prayer with Holy<br>Communion and sermon | £15.00     |
| Holy Baptism (as separate service)                                 | £11.00     |

(2) Reasonable travelling expenses shall be paid in addition to the fees specified in paragraph (1).

**Revocation**

3. The Sequestration Fees Order 1994(b) is revoked.
