



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (HAILWOOD AVENUE)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1997**

Coming into Operation: 4th February 1997

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3(1) and after having been satisfied that Section 1(8) of the Act does not apply the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Hailwood Avenue) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1997 and shall come into operation at 9.00 a.m. on 4th February 1997 or in the event of unforeseen circumstances or adverse weather conditions the closure may be postponed until 9.00 a.m. on 5th, 6th, 7th or 8th February 1997.

Closure of road to vehicular traffic

2. Subject to Article 3, no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a constable in uniform, cause any vehicle to proceed in that section of Hailwood Avenue from its junction with Governors Hill to its junction with Lakeside Road, Douglas.

Duration

4. The Order shall continue in force until 5.00 p.m. on the 4th February 1997 or in the event of unforeseen circumstances or adverse weather conditions 5.00 p.m. on 5th, 6th, 7th or 8th February 1997 or until the traffic calming work is completed, whichever is the earlier.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding in that section of Hailwood Drive, Douglas from its junction with Governors Hill to its junction with Lakeside Road whilst traffic calming work is being undertaken.

An alternative route will be via Lakeside Road.
