(MANX TELECOM CELLULAR SYSTEM) ORDER 1997**

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Council of Ministers by section 7(1) of the Telecommunications Act 1984(a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Public Telecommunication System Designation (Manx Telecom Cellular System) Order 1997 and, subject to section 44 of the Act, shall come into operation on the 1st March 1997.

(2) In this Order —

"the Act" means the Telecommunications Act 1984;

"the Manx Telecom cellular system" means the systems specified in Annex A of the licence under section 5 of the Act granted to Manx Telecom Limited by the Council of Ministers on the 28th October 1994.

Designation of system


2. The Manx Telecom cellular system, being a telecommunication system the running of which is authorised by a licence to which section 6 of the Act applies, is designated as a public telecommunication system.
