ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (CENTRAL PROMENADE)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF RIGHT TURN) ORDER 1997**

Coming in Operation : 10th February 1997

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3 (1), the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Central Promenade) (Temporary Prohibition of Right Turn) Order 1996 and shall come into operation on 10th February 1997.

Temporary prohibition of right turn

2. No person shall cause any vehicle proceeding on Central Promenade to make a right turn at its junction with Broadway Traffic Lights.

Duration

3. This Order shall continue in force until 27th March 1997 or until the pipe laying work in connection with IRIS is completed, whichever is the earlier.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit right turning movements of all vehicular traffic from Central Promenade at its junction with Broadway Traffic Lights whilst pipe laying work in connection with IRIS is being undertaken.

An alternative route will be to proceed southwards to Greensills Corner then return northwards in front of the Villa Marina to Broadway.
