



THE REPRESENTATION OF THE PEOPLE ACT 1995

THE POLLING DISTRICTS (PEEL) ORDER 1997

*Approved by Tynwald* 19 March 1997

*Coming into operation* in accordance  
with article 1

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Treasury by section 12(2) of the Representation of the People Act 1995(a), and of all other enabling powers, and after consulting each local authority whose district includes the whole or any part of the constituency to which it relates, the following Order is hereby made:—

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Polling Districts (Peel) Order 1997 and, subject to section 12(3) of the Representation of the People Act 1995, shall come into operation —

- (a) for the purposes of the preparation of registers of electors in 1997, on the 1st April 1997;
- (b) for all other purposes, on the 1st October 1997.

**Division of constituency into polling districts**

2. (1) The constituency of Peel is divided into the polling districts specified in the Schedule.

(2) In that Schedule "the order map" means the map annexed hereto and marked "Map referred to in the Polling Districts (Peel) Order 1997".

**Revocation**

3. The Polling Districts (Peel) Order 1996(b) is revoked.

**POLLING DISTRICTS**

<i>Number</i>	<i>Name</i>	<i>Area</i>
P1	Peel No. 1	That part of the constituency of Peel lying to the north-east of a line drawn from a point on the sea wall on Shore Road opposite its junction with Queen Street, in a generally easterly direction along the middle of Queen Street, Orry Lane, Michael Street, Atholl Place and Derby Road as far as its junction with the Kerroo Coar estate road, thence through the Kerroo Coar estate along a line more particularly shown by a broken black line on the order map, and thence in a southerly direction along the middle of Rheast Bridson to the south-east boundary of the constituency
P2	Peel No. 2	That part of the constituency of Peel lying to the south-west of the line described above
