**ATHOL PARK ROAD (PORT ERIN)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1997**

Coming into Operation: 24th February 1997

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 38 of the Highways Act 1986 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as Athol Park Road (Port Erin) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1997 and shall come into operation on 24th February 1997.

Closure of road to traffic

2. Subject to Article 3, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a constable in uniform, proceed or cause a vehicle to proceed in that section of Athol Park Road, Port Erin, from its junction with Strand Road to its junction with Athol Park/St Georges Crescent.

Exemptions

3. Article 2 does not apply to persons or vehicles requiring access to premises or land adjacent to the road specified in Article 2 or to :-

- (1) persons or vehicles engaged in any of the following operations :-
 - (a) works in land or premises adjacent to the road specified in Article 2;
 - (b) works in the road specified in Article 2 authorised by statutory provisions; or
 - (c) in the service of a local authority or the Department of Transport in pursuance of any statutory functions in the road or in adjacent land or premises if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes on any other road; or


- (2) persons or vehicles in the course of duty for the police, fire brigade, ambulance service or coastguard service; or
- (3) persons holding a permit issued by the Department of Transport for its use in the road, at a time or for a purpose specified in the permit; or
- (4) such persons and vehicles as may be authorised by the Department.

Duration

4. The Order shall continue in force until 23rd August 1997, or until the construction work is completed, whichever is the earlier.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular and pedestrian traffic from proceeding in that section of Athol Park Road, Port Erin from its junction with Strand Road to its junction with Athol Park/St Georges Crescent whilst construction work is being undertaken.

An alternative route will be via Droghadfayle Road and Shore Road.

Pedestrian access will be maintained from Glen View to Athol Park and from Athol Park to Athol Avenue.

Vehicle access will be maintained from Strand Road to Glen View and from Athol Avenue to St Georges Crescent.
