



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (QUEENS PROMENADE)
(TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF PARKING PLACES)(NO 1) ORDER 1997**

Coming into Operation : 28th February 1997

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3(1), the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Queens Promenade)(Temporary Suspension of Parking Places)(No 1) Order 1997 and shall come into operation on 28th February 1997

Temporary suspension of parking

2. No person shall cause any vehicle to be parked on Queens Promenade, Douglas from its junction with King Edward Road to a point abutting the hoarding relating to Contract III of the IRIS project.

Duration

3. This Order shall continue in force until 28th March 1997 or until the sewer work is completed, whichever is the earlier.
