**FEEs AND DUTIES ACT 1989**

**LEGALISATION OF DOCUMENTS (FEES AND DUTIES) ORDER 1997**

**Approved by Tynwald on 18 March 1997**

**Coming into operation on 20 March 1997**

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Treasury by section 1 of the Fees and Duties Act 1989(a), and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, the following Order is hereby made:

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Legalisation of Documents (Fees and Duties) Order 1997, and, subject to section 1(4) of the Fees and Duties Act 1989, shall come into operation on the 20 March 1997.

Fees in respect of the legalisation of documents

2. There shall be a fee of £12.00 payable in respect of attesting or legalising a signature and seal for Hague Convention countries and for the rest of the world.

The purpose of legalisation is to satisfy foreign authorities of the authenticity of a signature appearing on a document. The fee was last increased in May 1995.
