



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (LANE AT THE REAR OF RIDGEWAY STREET)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1997**

*Coming into Operation: 22nd February 1997*

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3 (1) and after having been satisfied that Section 1(8) of the act does not apply, the following Order is hereby made :-

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Lane at the rear of Ridgeway Street) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1997 and shall come into operation on 22nd February 1997.

**Closure of road to vehicular traffic**

2. Subject to Article 3, no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a constable in uniform, cause any vehicle to proceed in that section of the lane at the rear of Ridgeway Street abutting of the property numbered 9.

**Duration**

4. The Order shall continue in force until 25th February 1997 or until the electrical groundwork is completed whichever is the earlier.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not a part of the Order)*

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding in that section of the lane at the rear of Ridgeway Street, Douglas abutting the property No 9 whilst electrical groundwork work is being undertaken.

An alternative route will be via Lord Street.
