THE PAYMENT OF MEMBERS' EXPENSES ACT 1989
**THE PAYMENT OF MEMBERS' EXPENSES (SPECIFIED BODIES)
ORDER 1997**

Coming into operation 1st May 1997

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Treasury by sections 4(1)(a) and 5(1)(c)(iii) of the Payment of Members' Expenses Act 1989(a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Payment of Members' Expenses (Specified Bodies) Order 1997 and shall come into operation on the

3. The bodies listed in Schedule 2 are specified for the purposes of section 5 (travelling allowances) of the Act.

Revocation

4. The orders specified in Schedule 3 are revoked.
