



NON-RESIDENT TRADERS ACT 1983

NON-RESIDENT TRADERS (EXEMPTION) REGULATIONS 1997

Approved by Tynwald 15th April 1997

Coming into operation in accordance with regulation 1.

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Board of Consumer Affairs by section 8(1)(b) of the Non-Resident Traders Act 1983(a), and of all other enabling powers, and after consulting such organisations as it considers will represent interests which may be affected, the following Regulations are hereby made:-

Citation and commencement

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Non-Resident Traders (Exemption) Regulations 1997.
- (2) These Regulations shall come into operation on the date on which they are approved by Tynwald.

Exemption

2. (1) Non-resident traders who sell, expose or offer for sale or seek orders for the sale of any goods at a certified tourist event are exempt from the operation of the Non-Resident Traders Act 1983 when, and only when, -
 - (a) the traders are trading at a certified tourist site; and
 - (b) they are selling to or seeking orders for sale from participants; and
 - (c) the goods are for use by participants in the event.

- (2) In this regulation -

"certified tourist site" means a specific site in respect of which the Department of Tourism and Leisure has delivered a certificate to the Board of Consumer Affairs which identifies the site and certifies it to be -

- (a) a site at which a certified tourist event takes place; or
- (b) a place adjacent to a site at which a certified tourist event takes place; or
- (c) a place which is closely connected with the event by reason of the use of that place by participants;


"certified tourist event" means a tourist event in respect of which the Department of Tourism and Leisure has delivered a certificate to the Board of Consumer Affairs which identifies the event and certifies it to be of significant importance to the Island's tourist industry;

"participant" means any person who takes part in a certified tourist event, whether as a competitor, contestant, player, team member or in any other capacity and includes persons who (for the purposes of the certified tourist event) -

- (i) are in the service of or provide services (whether on payment or otherwise) to such participants; or
- (ii) are referees, umpires and other officials;

"site" includes a street or road and any course or circuit which is comprised of or includes streets or roads.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations are made by the Board of Consumer Affairs under the Non-Resident Traders Act 1983. The Regulations provide exemptions from the Act for certain classes of non-resident traders who sell, etc. to participants at important tourist events. The exemption will apply only in respect of tourist events which are certified by the Department of Tourism and Leisure and at sites which are certified by that Department.
