

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

### PARISH OF LONAN (PARKING PLACES) ORDER 1997

*Coming into Operation:* 30th April 1997

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 2 to the Act as required by Section 4A, the following Order is hereby made :-

#### **Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Parish of Lonan (Parking Places) Order 1997 and shall come into operation on 30th April 1997

#### **Interpretation**

2. "driver in relation to a vehicle waiting in the parking places means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place.

"parking place" means any part of the road authorised by this Order to be used as a parking place.

#### **Authorisation and use of parking place**

3. The part of the road specified in Column 1 of the Schedule may be used, subject to Article 4, as a parking place on such days and during such hours as are specified in relation to that part to the road specified in the Schedule.

#### **Other provisions**

4. (1) The driver of a motor vehicle using a parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the parking place, and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the parking place.

(2) No person shall use a vehicle, while it is in a parking place, in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near a parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skill or services.

(3) No person shall use any part of a parking place for the purposes of servicing or washing any vehicle part thereof other than is reasonably necessary to enable that vehicle to depart from a parking place.

(4) The Chief Constable may for good and sufficient reason prohibit the use of a parking place during such time as may be reasonably necessary.

(5) The Department may suspend the use of a parking place on giving notice of such seven days prior to such question.


#### SCHEDULE

Parts of Road authorised to to be used as a parking place	Maximum period during which vehicle may wait
Douglas/Laxey Road from a point abutting the northern boundary of Baldrine Post Office (Garwick Stores) northwards for a distance of 28m	30 minutes in any one hour.
