

HIGHWAYS ACT 1986

**VINTAGE MOTORCYCLE CLUB ASSEMBLY  
(CASTLETOWN MARKET SQUARE) (NO 1) ORDER 1997**

*Coming into Operation: 5th June 1997*

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 38 of the Highways Act 1986 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Vintage Motorcycle Club Assembly (Castletown Market Square) (No 1) Order 1997 and shall come into operation on the 5th June 1997.

**Interpretation**

2. In this Order:-

"Assembly" means the Vintage Motorcycle Club Assembly;

"Assembly period" means from the hour of 2.00 p.m. until the Assembly is officially notified as completed in accordance with Article 4, or until not later than the hour of 4.30 p.m., whichever may be the earlier;

"the Department" means the Department of Transport;

"promoter" means the Vintage Motorcycle Club Ltd.;

"scheduled road" means the road set out and described in the Schedule;

**Closure of road and temporary suspension and regulation of traffic**

3. On the 5th June 1997, during the Assembly period the scheduled road shall be closed to, and the right of vehicular traffic to proceed thereover suspended for all vehicular traffic other than such traffic as may be authorised by the promoter or by the Chief Constable.

**Duty of promoter to notify completion of assembly**

4. It shall be the duty of the promoter to make such provision as seems most expedient for giving official notification to the public of the conclusion of the Assembly and of the opening of the scheduled road to traffic.

**Erection of barriers and diversion signs**

5. During the Assembly period on the 5th June 1997, the promoter may cause barriers or diversion signs to be erected and maintained at or near to the junction of the scheduled road with those roads leading into the scheduled road. Such barriers and signs to be dismantled and removed immediately after the conclusion of the Assembly period.

**Notice of the making of the order**

6. Public notice of this Order shall be given in one Isle of Man newspaper.


SCHEDULE
