THE AIR NAVIGATION (RESTRICTION OF FLYING) (EXHIBITION OF FLYING)
REGULATIONS 1997

COMING INTO OPERATION

Whereas the Department of Transport deems it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of the places specified in column (1) of the Schedule hereto by reason of the intended holding of an Exhibition of Flying by the Red Arrows Display Team:

Now, therefore, the Department of Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 75 of the Air Navigation (No 2) Order 1995 (a), as it has effect in the Isle of Man and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Exhibition of Flying) Regulations 1997.

2. (1) Subject to paragraph (2), no aircraft shall fly within the area specified in column (2) of the Schedule below the altitude and on the date respectively indicated in columns (3) and (4) of that Schedule during the period notified for the purpose of these Regulations.

(2) Paragraph (1) of this Regulation shall not apply to any aircraft flying within that part of the area specified in paragraph (1) which falls within the Isle of Man Control Zone (CTR) or Isle of Man Control Area (CTA) as notified at RAC 3-5-15-1 in the United Kingdom Aeronautical Information Publication, in accordance with the permission of the Air Traffic Control Unit at Isle of Man Airport

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations impose restrictions on flying in the specified airspace during the period in which the Tynwald Day Church Service and Ceremony take place. This will serve to minimise nuisance on account of possible aircraft noise.

Prior to the Tynwald Day Ceremony a fly past of Royal Air Force Hawk Aircraft, to which these Regulations do not apply, will take place.


