



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**VICARAGE ROAD (BRADDAN)
(WEIGHT RESTRICTION) ORDER 1997**

Coming into Operation: 2nd May 1997

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 2 to the Act as required by Section 4A, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Vicarage Road (Braddan) (Weight Restriction) Order 1997 and shall come into operation on 2nd May 1997

Weight Restriction

2. Save as provided in Article 3, no person shall cause any vehicle the laden and unladen weight of which, exceeds 3 tonnes to proceed on Vicarage Road from its junction with Meadow Crescent to its junction with Stevensons Way in the Parish of Braddan.

Exemptions

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to proceed in the road referred to in that Article if the vehicle is being used :-

- (a) in exercise of its function as a fire brigade, ambulance or police vehicle;
- (b) as a Public Service Vehicle.
- (c) such other exemptions as to the occasional use that the Department may authorise in writing.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The effect of this Order is to impose a restriction on vehicles exceeding 3 tonnes in weight laden or unladen from using Vicarage Road from its junction with Meadow Crescent to its junction with Stevensons Way in the Parish of Braddan.
