



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

RURAL ROADS (SPEED LIMITS) (AMENDMENT) (NO 2) ORDER 1997

Coming into Operation: 2nd May 1997

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 2 to the Act as required by Section 4A, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Rural Roads (Speed Limits) (Amendment) (No 2) Order 1997 and shall come into operation on 2nd May 1997

Amendment of principal Order

2. The Rural Roads (Speed Limits) Order 1979 (b) shall be further amended so as to have effect in accordance with the following provisions of this Order


Imposition of Speed Limit

3. In Schedule 2 (Limits of Speed) after paragraph 5 (nn) insert the following :-

"(ii) Vicarage Road from its junction with Meadow Crescent
to its junction with Stevensons Way 20mph"
