#### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985**

#### ALBERT STREET (DOUGLAS) (DISABLED PERSONS' VEHICLE PARKING PLACES) ORDER 1997

Coming into Operation 9th May 1997

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 2 to the Act as required by Section 4A, the following Order is hereby made:-

#### Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Albert Street (Douglas) (Disabled Persons' Vehicle Parking Places) Order 1997 and shall come into operation on the 9th May 1997

## Interpretation

"driver" in relation to a vehicle waiting in the parking place means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place

"parking place" means any part of the road authorised by this Order to be used as a parking place

#### Authorisation and use of parking place

The part of the road specified in Column 1 of the Schedule may be used, subject to Article 4, as a parking place solely for disabled persons' vehicles in such position on such days and during such hours as are specified in relation to that part of the road specified in the Schedule

#### Other provisions

- The driver of a motor vehicle using a parking place shall stop the engine as soon 4. as the vehicle is in position in the parking place, and shall not start the enging except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the parking place
- No person shall use a vehicle, while it is in a parking place, in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near a parking place in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skills or services
- No person shall use any part of a parking place for the purpose of servicing or washing any vehicle part thereof other than is reasonably necessary to enable that vehicle to depart from a parking place
- The Chief Constable may for good and sufficient reason prohibit the use of a parking place during such time as may be reasonably necessary
- The Department may suspend the use of a parking place on giving notice of such seven days prior to such suspension

Albert Street southside from a point 34 metres west of its junction with Mount Havelock for a distance of 8 metres	Wholly within the limits of the parking place and parallel to the kerb	All days	All days	Only for persons having business at the Registry between the hours of 8.00 am and 6.00 pm Monday to Friday inclusive, vehicles may not wait for a period longer than 1 hour nor may they return to the space within 2 hours of leaving it
