



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985
**VARIOUS ROADS (PEEL)
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 1997**

Coming into Operation : 23rd May 1997

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 2 to the Act as required by Section 4A, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Various Roads (Peel) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Amendment) Order 1997 and shall come into operation on 23rd May 1997

Restriction of vehicles waiting

2. Save as provided in Article 3 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the sides of the length of road specified in the Schedule.

Exemptions

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the sides of the lengths of road referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable :-

- (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
- (b) goods to be loaded or unloaded from the vehicle;
- (c) the vehicle if it cannot be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations:-
 - (i) buildings or demolition operations;
 - (ii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said sides of the length of the road;
 - (iii) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to the said sides of the length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunications apparatus (within the meaning of the Telecommunications Act 1984) kept or to be kept installed for the purposes of a telecommunications code system (within the meaning of that Act)

(d) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties; or

(e) the vehicle to be used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.
