

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

MARASHEN CRESCENT (PORT ERIN) (ONE WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 1997

Coming into Operation : 18th June 1997

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 2 to the Act as required by Section 4A, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Marashen Crescent (Port Erin)(One Way Traffic) Order 1997 and shall come into operation on the 18th June 1997


Imposition of one-way traffic

2. No person shall, except upon direction or with permission of a police constable in uniform, cause any vehicle to proceed in that length of Marashen Crescent in the Village District of Port Erin, which borders the western, northern and eastern extremities of the play area otherwise than in an northerly, easterly and then southerly direction.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The effect of this Order is to require vehicular traffic to proceed in that length of Marashen Crescent in the Village of Port Erin which borders the western, northern and eastern extremities of the play area otherwise than in an northerly, easterly and then southerly direction.
