

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (NELSON STREET/MARKET STREET)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1998**

*Coming into Operation: 18<sup>th</sup> January 1998*

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3(1), the following Order is hereby made :-

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Nelson Street/Market Street) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1998 and shall come into operation at 8.30 a.m. on Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> January 1998

**Closure of road to vehicular traffic**

2. Subject to Article 3, no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a constable in uniform, cause any vehicle to proceed in that section of Nelson Street/Market Street, Douglas along the frontage of the Drumgold Street car park.

**Exemptions**

3. Article 2 does not apply to a vehicle requiring access to premises or land adjacent to the road specified in Article 2 or to -

(1) a vehicle engaged in any of the following operations :

(a) works in land or premises adjacent to the road specified in Article 2; or

(b) works in the road specified in Article 2 authorised by statutory provisions;  
or

(c) in the service of a local authority or the Department of Transport in pursuance of any statutory functions in the road or in adjacent land or premises if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes on any other roads, or

(2) a vehicle being used in the course of duty for the police, fire brigade, ambulance or coastguard service; or

(3) a vehicle for which the driver holds a permit issued by the Department of Transport for its use in the road, while the vehicle is being used at a time or for a purpose specified in the permit; or

(4) such vehicular traffic as may be authorised by the Department.


### Temporary suspension of enactments

4. The provisions of the entry No 20 of the One Way Traffic Order 1981 (b) with respect of one-way traffic in Market Street shall be suspended during the period of operation of this Order.

### Duration

5. The Order shall continue in force until 12.30 p.m. on Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> January 1998, or until the cleaning work is completed, whichever is the earlier.

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not a part of the Order)*

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding in that section of Nelson Street/Market Street, Douglas along the frontage of Drumgold Street car park whilst cleaning work is being undertaken.

The one-way traffic system on Market Street shall be suspended for the period this Order is in operation.
