



## HIGHWAYS ACT 1986

### VARIOUS ROADS (PEEL) FILMING ORDER 1998

*Coming into Operation : 1<sup>st</sup> February 1998*

In exercise of powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 38 of the Highways Act 1986 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made :-

#### **Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Various Roads (Peel) Filming Order 1998 and shall come into operation on Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> February 1998

#### **Interpretation**

2. In this Order :-

“the Department” means the Department of Transport;

“the promoter” means the producers of Dreaming of Joseph Lees;

“filming” means filming on the roads set out and described in the Schedule;

“filming period” means on 1<sup>st</sup> February 1998 from the hour of 5.00 a.m. until the filming is officially notified as completed in accordance with Article 4 or until not later than 12 noon whichever shall be earlier.

“Scheduled roads” means the roads set out and described in the Schedule.

#### **Closure of roads and temporary suspension of regulation traffic**

3. On the 1<sup>st</sup> February 1998 during the filming period the Scheduled roads shall be closed to, and the right of vehicular traffic to proceed therefore suspended for, all vehicular traffic other than such traffic as may be authorised by the promoter or by the Chief Constable.

### **Duty of the police to notify completion of filming**

4. It shall be the duty of the senior police officer present to make such provision as seems most expedient for giving official notification to the public of the conclusion of the filming and of the opening of the Scheduled roads to traffic.

### **Erection of barriers and diversion signs**

5. During the filming period the promoter will cause barriers and diversion signs to be erected and maintained at or near to the junction of the Scheduled roads with those roads leading into the Scheduled roads. Such barriers and diversion signs must be dismantled and removed immediately after the conclusion of the filming period.

### **Notice of the making of the Order**


6. Public notice of this Order shall be given by advertisement in two Isle of Man newspapers.

### **SCHEDULE**

1. Douglas Street from its junction with Market Place to and including its junction with Michael Street.
2. Lake Lane from its junction with Station Place to its junction with Church Lane.
3. Church Lane from its junction with St Peters Lane to its junction with Market Place.

An alternative route will be via East Quay.
