

HIGHWAYS ACT 1986

ST PETERS LANE (PEEL) FILMING ORDER 1998

Coming into Operation : 3rd February 1998

In exercise of powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 38 of the Highways Act 1986 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the St Peters Lane (Peel) Filming Order 1998 and shall come into operation on Tuesday 3rd February 1998

Interpretation

2. In this Order :-

“the Department” means the Department of Transport;

“the promoter” means the producers of Dreaming of Joseph Lees;

“filming” means filming on St Peters Lane in Peel;

“filming period” means on 3rd February 1998 from 12 noon until the filming is officially notified as completed in accordance with Article 4 or until not later than the hour of 12 midnight on 3rd/4th February 1998 whichever shall be earlier.

“Scheduled road” means the road set out and described in the Schedule.

Closure of road and temporary suspension of regulation traffic

3. On the 3rd February 1998 during the filming period the Scheduled road shall be closed to, and the right of vehicular traffic to proceed therefore suspended for, all vehicular traffic other than such traffic as may be authorised by the promoter or by the Chief Constable.

Duty of the police to notify completion of filming

4. It shall be the duty of the senior police officer present to make such provision as seems most expedient for giving official notification to the public of the conclusion of the filming and of the opening of the Scheduled road to traffic.

Erection of barriers and diversion signs

5. During the filming period the promoter will cause barriers and diversion signs to be erected and maintained at or near to the junction of the Scheduled road with those roads leading into the Scheduled road. Such barriers and diversion signs must be dismantled and removed immediately after the conclusion of the filming period.

Notice of the making of the Order


6. Public notice of this Order shall be given by advertisement in two Isle of Man newspapers.

SCHEDULE

St Peters Lane from its junction with East Quay to its junction with Church Lane.

An alternative route will be via East Quay.
