**THE HIGHWAY EXTINGUISHMENT (KING EDWARD VIII PIER, DOUGLAS)
ORDER 1998**

*Coming into Operation: 23rd June 1998
Approved by Tynwald: 18th March 1998*

*Coming into operation on the publication of notice of making the Order
in accordance with paragraph 10 of Schedule 3 of the Highways Act 1986.*

WHEREAS the Department of Transport is satisfied that it is expedient that the highway to which this Order relates should be extinguished for the purpose of enabling development to be carried out, and that an Order under section 33 (1) (b) and (6) of the Highways Act 1986 (a) should be made in respect of that highway.

AND WHEREAS the said Department has given public notice of the making of an Order as required by Part 1 of Schedule 3 to that Act.

IN exercise of the powers conferred on the said Department by section 33(1) and (6) of Paragraph 12 of Schedule 3 to the Highways Act 1986, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and interpretation

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Highway Extinguishment (King Edward VIII Pier, Douglas) Order 1998

(2) In this Order "the Act" means the Highway Act 1986.

Closure of highway

2. The highway specified in the Schedule is hereby extinguished.

Apparatus of statutory undertakers

3. Paragraphs 13 to 18 of Schedule 3 to the Act, shall not apply to any apparatus of statutory undertakers, in, upon, over along or across the highway specified in the Schedule.


SCHEDULE

Article 2

HIGHWAY TO BE EXTINGUISHED BY THIS ORDER

A rectangular area on the northern side of the King Edward VIII Pier in the Borough of Douglas from a point on the pier edge level with the gatehouse, 7 metres in a southerly direction followed by a straight line for 33 metres in a westerly direction parallel with the outer section of the pier edge then, at 90° to this line, to close with the pier edge and to enclose the area which is more particularly shown by a shaded area on the map annexed to this Order and marked 'Map referred to in the Highway Extinguishing (King Edward VIII Pier, Douglas) Order 1998.

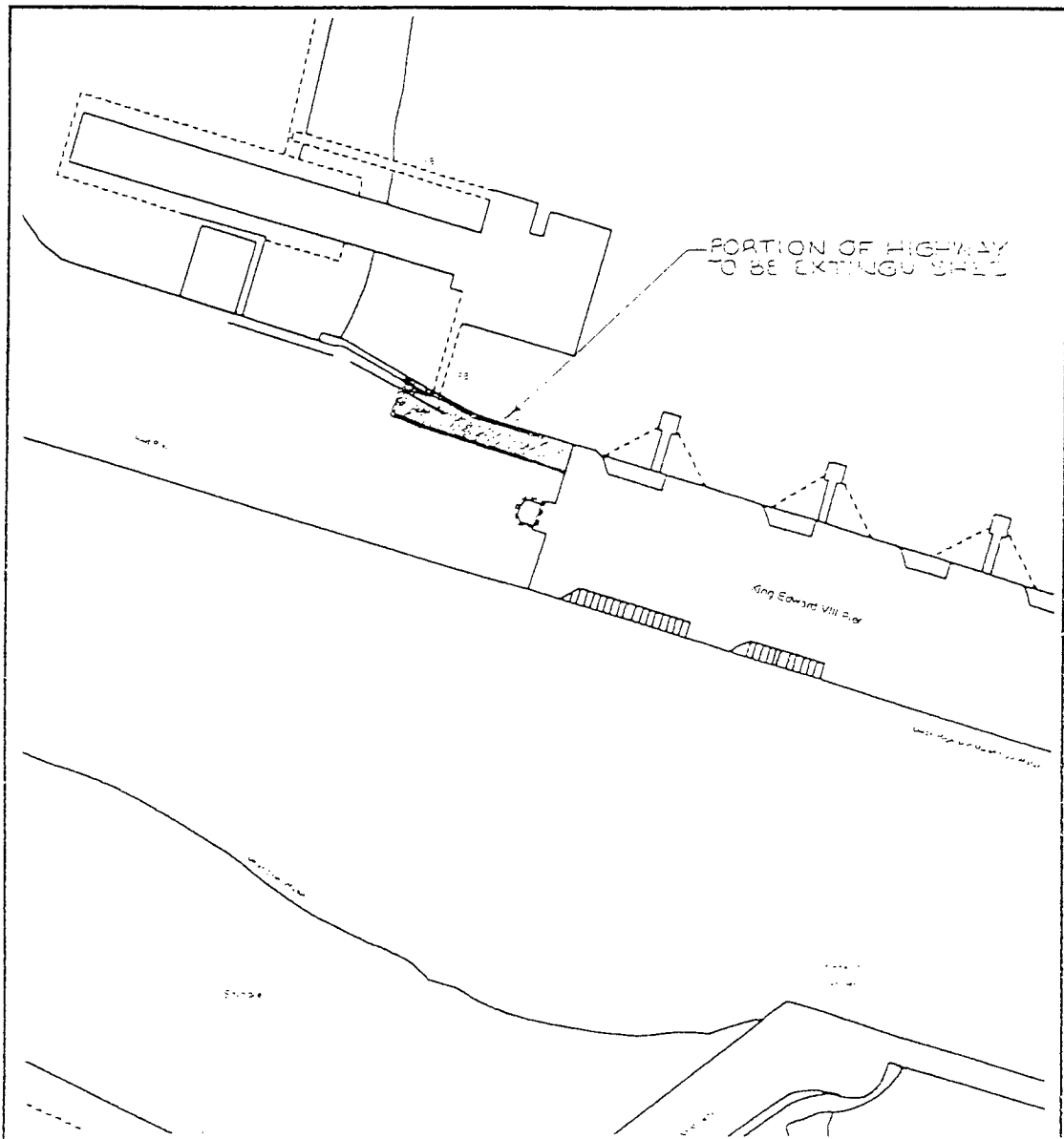
EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not a part of the Order)
