



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**A22 STRANG ROAD (BRADDAN)
(TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF WEIGHT RESTRICTION) ORDER 1998**

Coming into Operation: 10th February 1998

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3(9), the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the A22 Strang Road (Braddan) (Temporary Suspension of Weight Restriction) Order 1998 and shall come into operation on Tuesday 10th February 1998.

Temporary suspension of weight restriction

2. The provisions of the A22 Strang Road (Braddan) (Weight Restriction) Order 1997 (b) as it relates to that length of the A1 Douglas to Peel Road in Union Mills to its junction with the A23 Braddan Bridge to Crosby Road at Strang Cross Roads in the Parish of Braddan.

Duration

3. This Order shall continue in force until Friday 10th April 1998 or until the emergency repair work on Union Mills Bridge is completed whichever is the earlier.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not a part of the Order)

This Order effects the temporary suspension of the weight restriction of 7 ½ tonnes on the A22 Strang Road from its junction with the A1 Douglas to Peel Road in Union Mills to its junction with the A23 Braddan Bridge to Crosby Road at Strang Cross Roads in the Parish of Braddan, whilst emergency repair work is being undertaken on Union Mills Bridge.
