



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**B32 LHERGY CRIPPERTY ROAD (BRADDAN)
(TEMPORARY WEIGHT RESTRICTION) ORDER 1998**

Coming into Operation: 10th February 1998

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3(9), the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the B32 Lhergy Cripperty Road (Braddan) (Temporary Weight Restriction) Order 1998 and shall come into operation on Tuesday 10th February 1998.

Temporary weight restriction

2. Save as provided in Article 3, no person shall cause any vehicle the gross weight of which, exceeds 3 ½ tonnes to proceed along the length of the B32 Lhergy Cripperty Road, Braddan.

Exemptions

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to proceed in that length of the road referred to in that Article if the vehicle is being used with the prior approval of the Department of Transport.

Duration

This Order shall continue in force until Friday 10th April 1998 or until the emergency repair work on Union Mills Bridge is completed whichever is the earlier
