PARTNERSHIP (AMENDMENT) RULES 1998

Approved by Tynwald 18th March 1998

Coming into operation 1 April 1998

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Deemsters by section 59 (1) of the Partnership Act 1909(a), and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Treasury the following Rules are hereby made :-

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.
 - (1) These Rules may be cited as the Partnership (Amendment) Rules 1998.
 - (2) Subject to section 59 (2) (b) of the Act, these Rules shall come into operation on 1st April 1998.
 - (3) In these Rules, "the Act" means the Partnership Act 1909.

Fees in respect of Limited Partnerships

2. The fees set out in column 2 of the Schedule shall be taken in the General Registry in respect of the matters specified in column 1 of that Schedule.

Revocation

3. Paragraph 2 of the Rules made under Section 59 of the Act on 25th April 1913 is hereby revoked.


