### THE MEDICINES (PHARMACIES) (REGISTRATION FEES)

#### REGULATIONS 1998

*Laid before Tyrwald*                      *16<sup>th</sup> June 1998*

*Coming into Operation*                      *1<sup>st</sup> July 1998*

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry and the Department of Local Government and the Environment by sections 75(1), 76(1) and (2), 121 (1) and 124(1) of the Medicines Act 1976 (a), and all other enabling powers, and after consulting such organisations as appear to them to be representative of interests likely to be substantially affected, the following Regulations are hereby made :-

#### **Citation commencement and interpretation**

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Medicines (Pharmacies) (Registration Fees) Regulations 1998 and shall come into operation on the 1st July 1998.
- (2) In these Regulations "the Act" means the Medicines Act 1976.


#### **Registration fees for pharmacies**

2. (1) The fee payable for the purposes of section 75 of the Act in respect of the registration of any premises under that section shall be £71.00.
- (2) The retention fee payable under section 76(1) of the Act shall be £66.00.
- (3) The additional sum by way of penalty for the purposes of section 76 (2) of the Act shall be £202.00.

#### **Revocation**

3. The Medicines (Pharmacies) (Registration Fees) (No.2) Regulations 1997(b) are revoked.
