**EXPORT OF GOODS (UNITED NATIONS SANCTIONS) (SIERRA LEONE)  
(AMENDMENT) ORDER 1997 (APPLICATION) ORDER 1998**

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Treasury by section 1 of the Customs and Excise Act 1993<sup>(a)</sup>, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, the following Order is hereby made :-

**Citation, commencement and construction**

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Export of Goods (United Nations Sanctions) (Sierra Leone) (Amendment) Order 1997 (Application) Order 1998 and shall be construed as one with the Customs and Excise Acts (Application) Order 1979<sup>(b)</sup>.

(2) The applied legislation shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 19 December 1997.

**Interpretation**

2. In this Order, "the applied legislation" means the Export of Goods (United Nations Sanctions) (Sierra Leone) (Amendment) Order 1997<sup>(c)</sup>.

**Application**

3. The applied legislation shall apply to the Island, as part of the law of the Island, subject to the omission in Article 1 of the words from "and shall" onwards.

EXPLANATORY NOTE  
(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order applies to the Island an Order which amends the Export of Goods (United Nations Sanctions) (Sierra Leone) Order 1997 by revoking Article 2 of that Order. The revoked Article prohibited the export to Sierra Leone without a licence of the petrol and petroleum products listed in the Schedule to the Order. The revoked provisions are now included in the Sierra Leone (United Nations Sanctions) (Isle of Man) Order 1997<sup>(d)</sup> and this amendment is made to remove duplication.

2. Article 2 of the Export of Goods (United Nations Sanctions) (Sierra Leone) Order 1997<sup>(3)</sup> is hereby revoked.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends the Export of Goods (United Nations Sanctions) (Sierra Leone) Order 1997 by revoking Article 2 which prohibited the export to Sierra Leone without a licence of the petrol and petroleum products listed in the Schedule to the Order. Article 2 implemented in part United Nations Security Council Resolution 1132 (1997) of 8<sup>th</sup> October 1997. Those provisions are now included in the Sierra Leone (United Nations Sanctions) Order 1997 (S.I. 1997/2592) and this amendment is made to remove duplication.
