



HIGHWAYS ACT 1986

**RIVERSIDE INDUSTRIAL ESTATE(RAMSEY)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 1998**

Coming into Operation: 2nd March 1998

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 38 of the Highways Act 1986 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Riverside Industrial Estate (Ramsey) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 1998 and shall come into operation on Monday 2nd March 1998.

Closure of road to vehicular traffic

2. Subject to Article 3, by reason of construction work no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a constable in uniform, proceed or cause any vehicle to proceed in that section of the Riverside Industrial Estate from its cul-de-sac eastwards for a distance of 100 metres.

Duration

4. The Order shall continue in force until Monday 31st August 1998, or until the construction work is completed, whichever is the earlier.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit pedestrian and vehicular traffic from proceeding on that section of the Riverside Industrial Estate, Ramsey from its cul-de-sac eastwards for a distance of 100 metres whilst construction work is being undertaken.

An alternative route for pedestrians will be from the junction of Bircham Avenue and Station Road westwards along the disused railway line for a distance of 160 metres and then northeastwards for a distance of 80 metres to join public Right of Way 454 Poolydhooey Walk.
