



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (HOPE STREET)
(TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 1998**

Coming into Operation : 1st March 1998

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3 (1), the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Hope Street) (Temporary Suspension of One-Way Traffic) Order 1998 and shall come into operation on Sunday 1st March 1998

Temporary Suspension of One-Way Traffic

2. The provisions of entry No 16 of the One Way Traffic Streets Order 1981 (b) with respect of one way traffic in Hope Street, Douglas from its junction with Peel Road to its junction with Drinkwater Street shall be suspended.

Duration

3. This Order shall continue in force until Wednesday 4th March 1998 or until the road reconstruction work is completed, whichever is the earlier.
